


## PRONOLOGY rTB Quick Start Guide

## To power up the rTB:

- 1. Push the Power button the blue LED should light up
- 2. Connect the Thunderbolt 3 cable to your Mac or PC




Use the browser on the system and go to: <a href="https://www.pronology.com/rtb-drivers/">https://www.pronology.com/rtb-drivers/</a>
From the list, select the appropriate rTB driver download and launch.



## **Launch Web Management GUI**


For Mac, launch MRAID -> ArcHTTP64 to get to the RAID Management GUI



After the **ArcHTTP GUI** is open, double click on the "**ARC-1883LP Web Management**" to get into the Web GUI.

Login as "admin / 0000 "

From here on, refer to the RAID User Manual for setup/monitoring operations.



## Other Methods To Web Management GUI

The OS Driver must be installed by **MRAID** utility, no other ways around it.

But after the OS driver is installed, there is another method that allows you to do **remote Web GUI Management**.

- Plug a RJ45 LAN cable into the 1883 RAID adapter, and connect it with your local network.
- o Install **ArcSAP** utility in any system (PC or Mac) in the same network. **ArcSAP** can be download from the same URL, just scroll down the bottom of the page.
- o Launch ArcSAP, right click on "Network", and do "Rescan Network".

It should find the 1883 RAID Adapter.
